

How To Apply Adjust Invert Text/Line Weight

GX Print Server for PrimeLink™

Version 1.0

Overview

This exercise will demonstrate the ability to make changes to the default "Adjust Invert Text/Line Weight" setting. This feature is able to modify the outline to a specified density and achieve clearer, sharper printed results for text/line elements. It can be used to improve image quality when a design has reversed text and fine lines (i.e white text on a black solid).


Objective

By the end of this exercise you will be able to:


- Find the location of the setting on the GX Print Server


Adjust Invert Text Line Weight



1. In the shortcut area, select [Import Jobs].




- 2. Select a sample job to import
- Select [Hold] in [Operation After Importing] and [template_default] in [Template] and then click [OK].



4. Double-click the imported job to display job property.

5. Select [Job Settings] > [Image Quality] > [Printer].



Choose the required level of [Adjust Invert Text/Line Weight].



7. Click [Print] to print.
